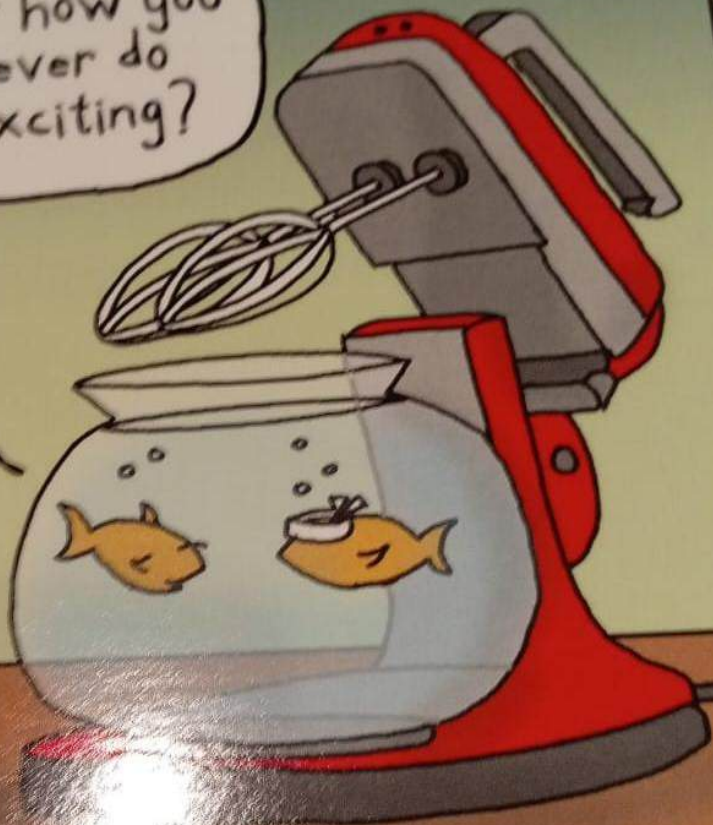




Jesus and his disciples went to Jericho. And as they were leaving, they were followed by a large crowd.

1 Corinthians 13 v1


